SERVICES PROVIDED

The Districts were organized in Denver County, Colorado and are governed pursuant to provisions of the Colorado Special District Act. The Districts were organized to finance, construct, acquire, and if required operate and maintain certain streets, traffic safety controls, street lighting, water, sanitary sewer, storm sewers and park and recreation improvements.

The District prepares its budget on the modified accrual basis of accounting.

REVENUE/ EXPENDITURES

The District expects no revenues or expenditures and has adopted a zero-dollar budget for the year ending December 31, 2022.
